Shared Classroom Supplies from each student, kept in class, to be shared (or submit a check for \$15 per student)

**Students with last name A – J**, bring these in **September**. **K – Z**, make a note in your calendar. Bring these in **January**.

( There is no need to write the student's name on shared classroom supplies. )

- Paper towels, two rolls per student
- 8 Letter-size manila file folders, 3-tab positions
- 1 small box tall kitchen trash bags (13 gal.)
- Fabric paint, any 2 colors  
(not fluorescent or glow-in-the-dark)

### Monthly students need the following supplies with them in their book bag:

- Notebook: 1½ -inch, 3-ring binder (D ring preferable)
- Mechanical pencils, 2 black Sharpie markers
- Colored pencils (PRISMACOLOR is an excellent brand.), pencil sharpener that collects pencil shavings
- 3 glue sticks, good quality scissors the student is comfortable using, Scotch tape, pencil box
- Water bottle (water only, please), lunch (Neither microwave nor refrigerator are available for food.)
- Backpack or fabric bag for all materials brought weekly
- Write student's name on all personal supplies.

### Earth Sciences Clearly write the student's name on supplies below.

- Exploring Creation with Astronomy Either 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> edition is fine. (Textbook only; no notebooking journal needed)
- The Geology Book by Dr. John D. Morris (Needed in December)
- The Weather Book by Michael Oard Either original or new book is fine. (Needed in March)
- T-shirt on a hanger: black, no pocket, long or short-sleeved, name written on the hanger and on the inside of the shirt
- Black umbrella (for November class) Write student's name on the handle.
- Flashlight (with regular bulb, not LED) with fresh batteries (for November class)
- Oatmeal box with plastic lid, cylinder type, 42 oz. size, empty (for November class)
- 1 styrofoam egg carton, size for 1 dozen eggs (for January class)
- Binoculars (optional, to be used at night to observe the edge of the half-moon or crescent-moon)

- Notebooking Journal for Human Anatomy & Physiology ( **1 per student** ) Regular version preferred (not junior)
