

Shared Classroom Supplies from each student, kept in class (Bring to 1ST class or submit a check for \$15 per student.)

- Paper towels, three rolls per student
- 12 Letter-size manila file folders, 3-tab positions
- Facial tissues, boutique size (cube-shaped box)
- 1 foam (core) board, any color, flat or tri-fold

Monthly students need the following supplies with them in their book bag:

- Notebook: 1½ -inch, 3-ring binder (D ring preferable)
- Mechanical pencils, black Sharpie
- Colored pencils (PRISMACOLOR is an excellent brand.), pencil sharpener that collects pencil shavings
- 3 glue sticks, good quality scissors the student is comfortable using, Scotch tape, package of brass brads, pencil box
- Water bottle (water only, please), snack or lunch (Neither microwave nor refrigerator are available for food.)
- Backpack or fabric bag for all materials brought weekly
- Write student's name on all personal supplies.

Science ABCs

- T-shirt on a hanger: any color, no pocket, long or short-sleeved, full name written on the inside **AND** on the hanger

Botany Clearly write the student's name on supplies below.

- Two small bags of potting soil (Bring **one** to class.)
- 4 plastic gallon milk jugs (washed clean; discard lids)
- Box (like the size that holds 10 reams of copy paper)
- Elmer's white glue
- Box of heavy duty foil
- Large, plastic lid (like the top of a cottage cheese container)
- Fluorescent spiral light & one outlet to socket light plug
- T-shirt on a hanger: any light color, no pocket, long or short-sleeved, full name written on the inside **AND** on the hanger
